THE CHRISTMAS OFFERING

A bed is a basic need for the well-being of a child, but nearly 800,000 children in the U.S. don't have one to sleep on, and almost half that amount do not have a safe home or family where they can grow into their fullest potential. This Christmas, you have the opportunity to help provide beds for children in our community, which provides safety, shelter, and belonging for children and youth with no family to support them. Part of your Offering will support our partnership with Sleep In Heavenly Peace. SHP partners with St. Luke's twice a year to build, assemble, and deliver top-notch bunk beds to children and families in need. Your Offering will help fund the building of over 150 beds this year.

We will also continue St. Luke's long-time tradition of supporting Residing Hope, formerly known as the Florida United Methodist Children's Home. This organization has supported children and families through residential care, therapeutic care, foster care, emergency shelter, independent living assistance, and community childcare for more than 100 years.
